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Guide to Upgrading SD Card – Cheetah PBX

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1 About This Document


1.1 Intended Audience


This document is for users who use the Telegato Cheetah PBX running on the Appliance hardware. Having a basic knowledge of Microsoft® Windows® is helpful but not required.

1.2 Conventions Used In This Document

This manual uses several conventions to help you learn to use the program quickly and easily.

Menus and dialog options that have an underlined letter in their name represent the shortcut key assigned to the menu or option. Pressing the shortcut keys assigned to the menu or option is equivalent to clicking the menu or option. For example, the following figure shows a sample menu that uses shortcut keys. Procedures in this manual reflect shortcut keys if they are available.

The Caution and Warning symbol,  indicates information or a step that could be potentially dangerous, such as a step that could permanently affect the database or a user's access to the program.

The light bulb,  indicates a tip or information that will help you in using this document.

2 Getting Started

One method of performing upgrades to the Cheetah PBX is to replace the SD card. This document describes the procedures necessary to perform this form of upgrade. The SD card is slot located in the back in the PBX. The following images show the insertion of an SD card into the back of the PBX.



2.1 Replacing the SD card on the Cheetah PBX

To replace the SD card on the Cheetah PBX, perform the following steps:

- 1 Using Remote Client, shut down the system. This is done by pressing the Processes button in Remote Client and then press the Disable button under Process Manager Control, then press Shut Down Application under System Control, and lastly press the Execute button. When finished, press the Close button. For more information, see the Remote Client User Guide.
- 2 Power off the system by removing the power.
- 3 Using a pointed object such as a pen, push the SD card in slightly, it should then come out enough to be removed with the pen (see the third picture, above).
- 4 Put the new SD card into the back of the Appliance and push in using a pen or similar object. When fully inserted the SD card is recessed slightly into the casing.
- 5 Power the Appliance back on.
- 6 Using the Remove Client, make sure application management is turned on. This is done by pressing the Processes button in Remote Client and then press the Enable button under Process Manager Control. If this already says Enabled, you may skip the rest of this procedure. Press the Close button. For more information, see the Remote Client User Guide.
